RULES & REGULATIONS:

In addition to the Roma Show Society Rules & Regulations listed at the front of the main schedule, the following will apply to this section.

1. All entries to be accompanied with a **"filled in"** entry form.
2. Exhibits must be the bona-fide work of the exhibitor.
3. Synthetic yarns are acceptable, but if entries are judged equal in quality, then **pure wool** has preference.
4. Exhibits (other than patchwork and tapestry) must not have been laundered.
5. Each exhibit is eligible for competition in one class only.
6. An entrant can submit no more than two entries in same class.
7. If you wish to sell your entry clearly mark with a Price or NFS. The Roma Show Society retains 20% of all sales.
8. **The pavilion will close at 6 pm on Saturday 13th May 2023. NO COLLECTION OF ENTRIES WILL HAPPEN AFTER CLOSURE.** Collection of entries will be on Sunday 14th May from 8:30am to 11:00am. If unable to collect your entries during this time please advise Chief Steward for alternative arrangement. Social distancing must be observed at all times.
