RULES & REGULATIONS:

In addition to the Roma Show Society Rules & Regulations listed at the front of the main schedule, the following will apply to this section.

The Chief Steward shall have the final say in all decisions regarding any event and entrance into events.

The Chief Steward can alter or remove any event within the 2023 Roma Show program.

Any competitor or persons associated displaying disruptive or offensive behavior at the discretion of the Chief Steward will be asked to leave the grounds immediately and excluded from participating in any further events.

Roma Show Ring Events are conducted within the relevant Biosecurity requirements / guidelines. All competitors must complete all Biosecurity documentation prior to competing.

1. No Stallion shall be allowed on the grounds without a bit or chain, and handler must be over 17 years of age.
2. Any horse mounted or ridden by a judge for the duration of the Roma Show 2023, other than when the horse is competing in an event in an arena will be disqualified from further competition.

Nominations

3. Nominations will be by ticket system.
4. Tickets will be available from the ringside ticket office the grounds from Thursday 9th May
5. Choose carefully **NO REFUND** given on pre-nomination or on the day nominations without a veterinary or medical certificate.
6. A Ticket to the value of the entry fee (inclusive GST) must accompany each nomination for each event.
7. Entry to judging arena for any event will be solely by ticket handed to the steward.

Marshalling

8. First call for competitors in any event will be five minutes before the program scheduled time (if any) for the event.
8a. It is the responsibility of each competitor to ensure that they are wearing the correct coloured arm band with the verification of Horse Health Declaration & Movement Form submitted.
9. Interested competitors should assemble with their horses in the marshalling area just outside the gate entry to the judging arena in time to hear the first call for their event.
10. Second call for competitors in any event will be to signal entry to the judging arena and hand tickets to stewards.
11. On completion of Second Call and at the discretion of the Gate Steward, he will secure the gate and advise the Chief Steward that all interested competitors have now entered the arena and judging may commence. All horses are to exit through the marked gates, exiting horses have right of way. All entering horses must wait until exiting horses are through the gate. This is in the interest of competitor's safety.



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12. A '**Newcomer**' is a Pony, Galloway, Hack or Horse that has not competed under saddle at any show or competition (except for racing) prior to 1 July 2021. Winners of Newcomer classes are **not** eligible for Champion
13. A '**Maiden**' is a Hack, Galloway or Pony that has not won a hack class in competition at an affiliated show. After winning a maiden hack class this horse will be recognised as a Novice (Ring 1&2).
14. A '**Novice**' is a Hack, Galloway or Pony that has not won an Open Championship at an Agricultural Show or a first at a Royal or HOTY in hack classes (Ring 1&2).
15. An '**Intermediate**' is a horse that has not won a first, second or third in a similar event at a Royal Show.

Hacks

16. The height of Hacks at the Roma Show shall be over 15 hands. All Hacks must be measured and be able to produce an official height certificate.

Galloways

17. The height of Galloways at the Roma Show shall be over 14 hands, up to and including 15 hands. (Any horse measuring exactly 14 hands is a Pony for this Show: any Horse measuring exactly 15 hands is a Galloway for this Show). Ladies Galloway and Ladies Hack must be ridden by Lady 17 years and over. Gents Galloway and Gents Hack must be ridden by Gent 17 years and over.

Ponies

18. The height of pony for District/Novice/Open pony hack classes at the Roma Show shall be up to and including 14hh. All ponies must be able to produce an official height certificate.
19. All ponies under 12.2 hds must be ridden by a child under 17 years.

District Qualification

20. All persons and horses must reside, and upon proof thereof, for at least three calendar months prior to May 2021 in the Maranoa Regional Council, are eligible to compete in all District events.
21. Residents of fringe areas of the above Shires and Town not classified as district competitors for any other Show may, on written application to the Roma Show Society Inc. be approved as District competitors for the 2021 Roma Show. Any such approval must be produced on demand.

Led Classes

22. In all Led Breed Classes papers, proof of age, breeding, registration, and membership **MUST BE PRODUCED on demand by the Chief Steward or Steward in charge of the ring.**
23. Any horse that is dual registered may compete in one or more classes as long as the horse is registered with that association and that association approves.

Protests

24. In the event of a dispute, the Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies shall apply.
25. The Ring Master shall have the power to ban from competition any competitor whose behavior to a Judge and/or Steward is considered offensive by the Judge, Steward or Ring Master.
26. Persons must lodge protests with \$100 bond which will be forfeited if protest is turned down and refunded if protest upheld.

Age

27. If requested by Stewards, children must be able to produce proof of age in Classes with age barriers, by producing an original copy of a Birth Certificate.

Measuring

28. All horses are required to be measured by a Steward. When measuring, an allowance of one half of an inch is to be made for shoes. Where an exhibitor disagrees with the Official Measurer's height for a horse which has been measured with shoes on, he may, should he so desire have it re-measured without shoes.
29. Times for measuring will be on display at the temporary office at the horse section.

Horse Stalls

30. HORSE STALL PAYMENT MUST BE MADE IN FULL BEFORE STABLES ARE ALLOCATED.
31. There are a limited number of stables.

Camping and stabling booking forms are online and can be completed and e-mailed to horses@romashow.com prior to payment, to provide stewards with an early indication of the number of stables/yards and camping spaces required.

A link will be provided to NOMINATE to facilitate payment after 1st April 2023.

No applications will be taken prior to 1st February 2023.

It is suggested that competitors who have booked stables or yards download the Nominate App so that they can check in upon arrival. All persons on the grounds must be accountable either through Nominate check in Arm bands will be provided.
No armband, no competition.



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32. All Show Horse stabling enquiries should be to Sharon Bruce 0409 898 110.
33. Upon arrival on the grounds, please check to find stable allocations on each stable row.
34. NO REFUND GIVEN without vet or medical certificate
35. No straw is allowed in the stables – bedding will be provided.
36. Local horses (within 35km radius) will only be allocated when all traveling horses have been accommodated

Camping

37. All exhibitors who desire to live on the grounds must place their truck or caravan in the allotted camping area. This will be at a cost of \$28.00 for the duration of the Show Any exhibitor refusing to abide by these instructions may be ejected from the grounds and disqualified from further participation in the Show. The Society notifies that it intends to enforce this rule strictly. Toilet and Shower facilities are provided, and electricity is available.
38. All competitors must either be members or pay through the gate. Arm bands will be issued. No band no competing! This is part of our Co-vid safe plan.

Working Australian Stock Horses

39. Working ASH classes are to be ridden in a snaffle bit. Competitors competing in Classes 7-11 & 38-43 must be current members of the ASH Society

Show & Working Hunter Classes (156-180)

40. Horses must either compete in the Hunter Ring or Open Hack or Pony Hack Ring (Saturday), they may not compete in both (with the exception of district hack classes).
41. Classes 178-180 will be judged as per the guidelines Refer to the 'Guide to Working Hunter Classes' as set out on website:- www.hunterhorses.com.au (Rules and Regulations tab) before entering this ring.
42. Stallions are eligible to compete (handler/rider must be over 17 years)
43. Newcomers see rule 12
44. Hunter Ponies over 12.2 hands may be ridden by an adult
45. A '**Novice**' is a *horse, Galloway or pony* that has never won a first place in a similar event in the Open Ring of a Hack, Breed or Agricultural Show
46. An '**Intermediate**' is a horse or rider that has not won a first, second or third in a similar event at any Royal.
