### **Conditions of Entry**

1. All entries through nominate.com.au – no late entries accepted
2. Current Equestrian Australia (EA) national dressage rules and tests apply and officials, riders and spectators are accountable and responsible to be aware and abide by them at all times.

3. Entries without a confirmed event agreement, risk warning, release and indemnity (agreement) will not be accepted.
4. Classes 1-8 are open to current Equestrian Queensland (EQ) Junior Competitive riders ONLY and are Interschool Queensland Qualifying classes. Classes 9-18 are open to current financial Maranoa Equestrian Club Inc (MEC) Riding Members or Roma Show Members ONLY. All class numbers will be limited and capped at the discretion of the Organising Committee (OC).
5. Entrants ride at their own risk and no responsibility will be taken for loss or damage to rider, horse, spectator or equipment. All athletes ride under the Rules, Regulations and By-Laws of EA, and relevant club / society membership applicable to this competition and the rules of the relevant sport. Riders are responsible to be familiar and practice in accordance to these. The Welfare and protection of horse and athlete is paramount at all times and in accordance with current EA Guidelines. The Judge and OC's decision on any given competition/clinic day for any given incident remains final. It may be deemed necessary for any rider to gain clearance from a Medical Officer and/or Vet (where requested) before continuing on in the competition. If a rider chooses to ignore the request, they remount at their own risk and are immediately eliminated from the competition. The OC and its responsible persons take no responsibility or liability with regards to that persons chosen decision. Riders have a responsibility, in the event that they have had a suspected concussion within the 4 weeks leading up to the event, to declare this with the OC prior to the event. Maranoa Equestrian Club (MEC) Members ride in accordance to the MEC constitution, rules and regulations and Roma Show Riding Members ride in accordance with the Roma Show Society Constitution, rules and regulations.
6. The OC reserves the right to alter the program at any given time.
7. Maximum of 2 dressage tests per horse per day. Tests can be over two consecutive levels, as per EA Rules AND Each Rider may compete in a maximum of six (6) tests/day. Riders must be prepared to ride to timed draw.
8. One rider only per horse; including warm-up.
9. IQ Riders: Class 1-8 Competitors must provide their EQ number when nominating. IQ numbers will be allocated and included with the Draw when emailed out where relevant. Relevant results will be forwarded to IQ at the conclusion of the event by the OC.
10. IQ numbers (riders in classes 1-8) must be worn on both sides of the horse and clearly visible at all times.
11. IQ School Equestrian Team uniform must be worn when competing in IQ classes.
12. No refunds after close of entries unless substantiated with medical and/or veterinary certification within 7 days of the completion of the event to the OC. Note the \$10/rider admin. fee is non-refundable and will be retained by the OC.
13. Objections: Attention is drawn to the current Australian Dressage Rules and official procedure for dressage competitions. Only the owner/rider of a horse taking part in the competition may lodge a protest. This must be in writing to the OC on the day with a \$100 deposit not later than 30 minutes after the happening that gave rise to the protest or in the case of the disqualification of the competitor, not later than 30 minutes before the start of the class.
14. The OC reserves the right to accept or reject entries according to special circumstances.
15. In the event of illness or accident to rider prior to the commencement of the event, a substitute rider may be arranged (OC to be notified); however a substitute horse cannot be placed instead of the nominated horse.
16. Riders not at presentation of prizes, forfeit their prizes unless a pre-paid Self-addressed envelope is left with the OC.

17. This competition has adopted all guidelines and recommendations in EA's Stallion Safeguard Guidelines. Stallion owners need to be aware and comply with the guidelines at all times. All other riders are to be aware of stallions on the ground.
18. In the case of cancellation of the event, an administration fee of 20% of total entries may be retained by the organizers.
19. Supervision of horses is the sole responsibility of the owner/rider and any horse or competitor behaving in a disruptive or dangerous manner may be eliminated and asked to leave the venue by the OC.
20. Timed Draw: will be emailed to riders in a timely fashion prior to the commencement of competition.
21. HHD must be completed, printed and handed in to Gear check steward at the commencement of this event.
22. Confirmed relevant club / society membership **MUST** accompany entry.
23. Champion/Reserve Champion: Points will be awarded to horse and rider combinations for each relevant test for 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place (1<sup>st</sup> = 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 9 points...continue until 10<sup>th</sup> = 1 point). The rider/horse combination with the highest tally of points at the conclusion of both relevant classes for that level (i.e., both Junior Participant Prelim classes, both club prelim classes, both club novice classes) will be awarded Champion, and the rider with the second highest tally will be awarded Reserve Champion. In the event that two riders are tied, it will be awarded to the rider with the highest percentage tally when both relevant percentages from the respective classes are tallied.
24. Dress Standards: As per section 5 – Dress Saddlery and Equipment – Equestrian Australia National Dressage Rules
25. Helmets: Riders are responsible to ensure helmets are secured when mounted and compliant with current EA General Regulations and rules. NB. Helmet Tagging will be mandatory for all EA Affiliated Dressage events from 1 July 2022.

26. As per National Dressage Rules, section 3.23 - Fall or injury to horse or rider:  
In the event of a fall by horse or rider or other traumatic incident the following applies: a) it is the decision of the OC's designated first aid official to assess whether the rider may continue to compete at the event without first getting a medical clearance b) where a knock to the rider's head or body that transmits a force to the head is suspected, refer to Annex G – the EA Policy applies c) in the case of the horse, a vet or horse welfare officer will assess if the horse can continue to compete in that event. The organising committee have the right to ask a rider to dismount due to any incidents. This decision is final, and rider must dismount when asked.
27. JOBS: Failure to fulfil your entire allocated job time AND requirements, will result in IMMEDIATE ineligibility for prizes and disqualification from the event – unless the rider is willing to pay the \$50 'no-job' fee at that time. It remains the SOLE responsibility of the allocated rider to find, negotiate and swap jobs with another rider if they are unable to fulfil their rostered duties. ## EVENT AGREEMENT, RISK WARNING, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY (AGREEMENT)

### ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

1. I acknowledge and agree that:
  - a. taking part in horse sports is a dangerous recreational activity and serious injury (including spinal injury, brain or head injury, fractures, soft tissue injury and mental anguish and emotional disturbance) or death may result from participating in horse-related competitions or activities;
  - b. horses may act in a sudden and unpredictable manner, and EA and the Member Branch does not make any representations or warranties as to how a horse may act; and
  - c. I participate in any event held or managed by the Member Branch (and its affiliated clubs, associations and committees) (**Activities**), at my OWN RISK.
2. I have read, understood and agree to abide by this Agreement, all and any rules, regulations, policies and codes (including the Code of Conduct) of EA and the Member Branch, and any organiser or manager of Activities, as may be in force from time to time, and acknowledge and agree that:
  - a. EA and the Member Branch's publication of any amended rules, regulations, policies and codes shall be deemed to be sufficient notice to me of the current rules, regulations, policies and codes of EA and the Member Branch; and
  - b. any misconduct (as determined by the Member Branch or the relevant Activities organiser, in their sole discretion) or refusal by me to follow any direction of the Member Branch or an Activities organiser, may result in my immediate disqualification from the Activities and the forfeiting of all fees paid in relation to those Activities.

### RELEASE, INDEMNITY AND WAIVER

3. To the maximum extent permitted by law:
  - a. 9. I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for my safety in my participation of the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
10. I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
11. I use the Suppliers' facilities, including for the Event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me, both obvious and inherent.
